
Selling points:








About the book:




AUTHORS



HALYNA MALYK

An award-winning Ukrainian children's writer and translator. She is a member of the National Union of Writers of Ukraine. Her works have been translated into several languages.



HANS CHRISTIAN ANDERSEN

The tales of this Danish writer have been translated into more than 150 languages and adapted for films, cartoons, and theater. Andersen's heyday of creativity happened in the second half of the 1830s, when he wrote 156 fairy tales. It was the genre where his artistic talent was the most evident. His tales are closely related to folklore and are very dynamic, humorous, whimsical, and satirical and also reveal the critical social issues of his times.



KATERYNA PERKONOS

A Ukrainian author of children's books, editor, and teacher. She writes cardboard books for the youngest readers aged 0+. The main purpose of Kateryna's books is to show children that reading isn't something boring, but it's like an exciting journey to the new worlds.



SLAVA SVITOVA

A Ukrainian author of books for children and grown-ups and a co-author of numerous books of collected stories. Her books won Ukrainian prizes, and some were translated into other languages. Slava is a women empowerment activist, a co-founder of Creative Women Space and Creative Women Publishing, and a creativity and writing coach working with women beginner writers to help them unleash their creative potential, and find the genuine voice to tell their stories to become visible in the world. She lives in Kyiv with her daughter where she writes books. She currently calls herself "a woman who writes and publishes books in Ukrainian languages at wartime".



OKSANA KROTIUK

A Ukrainian children's writer, a member of the National Union of Writers of Ukraine, and amember of the National Union of Journalists of Ukraine.

IRYNA RUTYLO

An illustrator from Lviv, who has been in love with art, books and people since childhood. Since 2015, she's been diving into illustration and constantly learning from professionals and experimenting. Illustration is a natural occupation for Iryna, as described by famous Ukrainian philosopher Hryhorii Skovoroda. Since 2017, she has been giving life to ideas of Ukrainian and foreign authors, publishers, and businessowners.



INNA RUDA

A freelance illustrator based in Kyiv, Ukraine, who loves acrylics, color pencils, and family. Having worked as a designer and art director in advertising and IT, she finally had the courage to settle in illustration, making images for products for kids, such as puzzles, plates and cups, illustrations for children's literature and magazines.



GRASYA OLIIKO

A young talented artist who communicates with the audience through her drawings. After graduating with a Law degree, Grasya did not abandon her favorite pastime of creating illustrations. Eventually, the artist studied professionally, and devoted herself fulltime to art. "Illustration is a huge infinite universe where you can find something new every day. That's what inspires me to constantly work on myself," she said.



HALYNA VERHELES

An Illustrator, designer, based in Kyiv, Ukraine. Develops her projects in the context of Ukrainian culture, studied book design, layout, typography. Works with ukrainian and foreign publishings.



KOST LAVRO

An outstanding artist of contemporary book graphics. One of the most remarkable and creative masters of Ukrainian book illustration. He combines the style of Ukrainian avant-garde of 1920s with the most famous features of Ukrainian folk painting. Kost Lavro has created his own unique, vivid and in the same time deeply national style. Kost Lavro's works have been included in catalogs of the most prestigious children's book exhibitions such as Bologna, Bratislava etc. Rights to his books have been sold to famous publishing houses from the USA, Switzerland, France and other countries.
